ORDER

NO. DHFW/COVID-19/CH/2021/ :: In view of saturation of Covid Beds in the District Hospital Dimapur owing to exponential surge in new cases and detection of Covid-19 among patients admitted for other health problems increasing the risk of transmission to the HCWs, in the interest of public health and safety, the District Hospital Dimapur is hereby designated as Covid Hospital till further order.

However, emergency services shall be continued till alternative arrangements are made for delivery of essential healthcare services. The Medical Superintendent is directed to undertake the following measures:

1. To continue management of already admitted patients till they are fit for discharge, while ensuring utmost care to prevent the risk of transmission.
2. To maintain an Isolation ward to keep suspected cases till result is declared.
3. To setup triaging system for prompt identification and delivery of services to serious patients.
4. Except for confirmed Covid-19 cases requiring hospitalization, no non-covid-19 cases shall be admitted.
5. For optimum utilisation of resources, all asymptomatic/ presymptomatic and mild cases which do not require hospitalization are to be admitted/ transferred to CCC or Home Isolation.
6. To expand the capacity of Oxygen supported beds and ICU, and to ensure adequate supply of oxygen and other essential medicines and consumables. To this effect, proposal may be submitted to the undersigned for additional logistic requirements.
7. Ensure rational deployment of manpower on-Covid duty based on case load and in conformity with the extant policy vide this office order even number datedHCWs not on-covid duty are to be put on delivery of essential healthcare services.
8. Ensure rigorous in-house training of all category HCWs on various aspects of Covid-19 management.
9. Arrange deployment necessary security measures through District Task Force.
10. In coordination with District Task Force, identify suitable Government health facilities for delivery of essential healthcare services including OT services.


