They may be assigned to keep strict vigil of any breach of mandatory Home Quarantine any person and in such situation to immediately inform to the nearest Administrative Officer.

It may be stated here that any act of non-compliance shall be deemed to have committed an offence punishable as per the provisions of the Epidemic Disease Act, 1897.
