In pursuance to Govt. approval No. HFW-5/A/MISC/37/2010/469/ Dated, Kohima the 25th Sept 2020, interested candidates from bonafide Indigenous Inhabitants for the State of Nagaland are invited for undergoing Training in General Nursing & Midwifery (GNM) and Female Health Worker (FHW) for the session 2020-2021 for the 4 (Four) Schools of Nursing in Nagaland as indicated below.

1. Minimum and maximum age for admission will be 17 – 25 years on or before 31st Dec 2020.
2. Application Form duly filled up along with necessary documents duly self attested may be submitted along with the Schedule Tribe and Indigenous Inhabitant Certificate which is compulsory for all while submitting the form.
3. No separate calling letter will be issued.

5. Last date of submission of Application Form(s) online shall be 12th October 2020. Duly filled in application in PDF format along with requisite supporting documents should be submitted through email to: hfw.recruitment2020@gmail.com

 - A. (GNM) (School of Nursing, NHAK, IMDH Mokokchung, D.H. Dimapur)
 - i. Male and unmarried Female candidates
 - ii. 3 (Three) years course, 100 (one hundred) seats.
 - iii. Qualification – Class 12 passed any stream with 40%, preferably Science
 - B. (FHW) (School of Nursing, D.H. Tuensang)
 - i. Unmarried Female candidates.
 - ii. Two years course, 30 (Thirty) seats.
 - iv. Qualification – Class 12 passed any stream.
7. No written examination will be conducted. Therefore, selection of candidates will be purely based on academic performance (marks) in the qualifying examination.
8. No Application Forms will be issued from the Office.
9. Incomplete Application, if submitted will be rejected summarily. List of rejected application will be published in the Office Notice Board.


